The EWG tested all sorts of personal care products, but let's look at the results of their analysis of skincare products (and one more which really shocked me)...

1,4-Dioxane showed up in:

- 36% facial moisturizers
- 35% anti-aging products
- 34% body lotion
- 33% around eye creams

Here's the extra one I wanted to slip in...

- 57% baby soap

That's right... this carcinogenic contaminant (which can be easily removed) showed up in 57% of baby soaps.

That was in 2007, and this stuff is still prevalent!

And legal...

It kinda makes me mad!
